PC06/22 Apologies for Absence – No Apologies received.

PC07/22 Declarations of Interest – Cllr Chappell noted that whilst not a direct neighbour an application to demolish a property had been received on the estate where they live.

PC08/22 - **Public Participation** – A representative from Escomb House Independent School attended to advise Members that their organisation are in talks with the owners and the Escomb Road Annex near the hospital with the plans to create an in depended special school for up to 25 young people with EHC (Education Health Care Plan). It would be the first school of its kind in Bishop Auckland. They organisation wanted to approach the Town Council before they submitted any planning applications etc as they wanted the Council to be aware of their intentions. They invited the Committee Members to a site visit.

Resolved: That Members would attend the site visit to learn more about the plans. They also thanked the representative for speaking to them in advance of any pre-planning consultation.
