PR0056.1/23 Budget Preparation – (see file copy)To remove room hire from the budget planning as still waiting for confirmation from the Parkinson partnership regarding Tax repayment before a decision can be made on renting out rooms. Changes to funding allocation areas suggested were discussed.

Deficit discussed and the requirement to increase the precept in order to protect the reserves.

Ready reckoner detailed an increase of:

Band A increase of £14.07 per year (27p per week increase)

Band D £21.10 (40p per week increase)

Overall this is £5.52 increase per head of population

Option 2 – to present an increase above this with options as to what additional benefit it will give. Such as additional monies to community support such as grants, events, or providing additional services to support communities etc.
