TC01/22 Election of Mayor – The nominations for Mayor for the 2022-23 Municipal Year were proposed. Only one nomination was received which was for Cllr Michael Siddle.

Resolved: That Cllr Michael Siddle be elected as mayor for the municipal year 2022-23. This was proposed by Cllr Jamie Blackburn and Seconded by Cllr Sam Zair

TC02/22 Declaration of Acceptance of Office – The Mayor Cllr Siddle signed a declaration of acceptance of office.

Resolved: The Cllr Siddle signed the declaration of acceptance of office.

TC03/22 Presentation to Retiring Mayor - A vote of thanks was given to Cllr Katie Eliot, as the retiring Mayor, and she was presented with a medal and flowers to commemorate her time in office. Katie was thanked for her hard work over the term and for her valiant fundraising effort which saw her raise over £3000 for the local hospital.

Resolved: That their apologies be noted and accepted.

TC05/22 Declarations of Interest – No declarations of interests were made.

TC06/22 Election of Deputy Mayor - To elect a Deputy Mayor for the 2021-2022 Municipal Year.

Resolved: The nominations for Deputy Mayor for the 2022-23 Municipal Year were proposed. Only one nomination was received which was for Cllr Sam Zair.

That Cllr Siddle would take the CDALC Larger Councils forum seat, and the CDALC AGM seat.

That the Stronger Towns Board Position be available to both the Mayor and Town Clerk

That Cllr Balmer-Howison would remain on the Bishop and Shildon Local Councils Committee with the option to have the CDALC Exec seat for 2 years on Rotation with Shildon. For the second two years that seat would change to the AAP Board member for the area to ensure that Bishop Councillors received some representation.

TC15/22 Report of Town Clerk

- a) Jubilee Celebrations 2022 An update on the Platinum Jubilee Celebrations to celebrate HM the Queen's 70 year reign was given. Three days of celebrations were planned. The initial budget was £15,000, with an additional £10,000 received from the Awards for All. Based upon the estimates etc it was anticipated that there was a gap of £10-12, 000 in the events budge to successfully deliver the three day event programme.
 - **Resolved:** That the DCC members be approached for funding support. That the Town Council use the 'Ward and In year events' budget allocation of £5000 towards the events, plus reserves as they wish the event to be a huge celebration.
- b) Mayoral Chain Request has been made to DCC for the Wear Valley Chain and a price for Repairs has been quoted. Resolved: That the Council waits for a response from DCC and alternative prices for repairs or a new Chain be requested.
- c) Work Programme Update the Clerk updated that the work programme was being developed and it would be brought to a future meeting with the proposals for changes to the Town Council Plan.

Resolved: That the report is noted.

d) Finance – In accordance with delegated powers, payments had been made as detailed in the report. (See Appendix 2) and cheques were presented for authorisation also as detailed in appendix 2.
