Allotments provide an excellent opportunity for people to grow their own produce and at the same time get plenty of fresh air and exercise. Produce grown can contribute to a healthy balanced diet and is also a social activity.

Allotments come in a variety of shapes and sizes and the size of the plot will determine the amount of rent charged. The current rate is 27p per square metre (Sq/m) and it is reviewed each year. Potential tenants would be expected to achieve a minimum of 50% cultivation of the total available area of a plot.
