The Auckland Project

In the lead up to the big Christmas tree light switch on in the Market Place, the Auckland Project is sending specially designed lantern templates to schools across the town to decorate and make, with 1,000 lucky children being given special battery lights to put inside them and bring them along on the 1st of December.

Each school will receive 100 lanterns and 50 lights – with more lanterns available on request – as well as a specially produced pack for teachers full of activities and information which links the lanterns with Auckland Castle's history, the magnificent Deer Park, and the forthcoming Faith Museum.
