CC012/24 – Community Support Feedback

CC013/24 – Community Support Funds

The Acting Clerk advised of funds remaining in the 2024/25 financial year for School Holiday Support and Community Organisations Support which equates to £14,000. A list of donations to help a vast number of groups from young to old covering aspects of physical and mental health, support groups, social groups, special needs groups were incorporated.
