Finkle Street, Bishop Auckland – Footway Improvements

We are writing to inform you that improvement works to the footways will begin shortly at Finkle Street, Bishop Auckland.

- **Working hours:** 07:30 to 15:30

Finkle Street will remain open to vehicular traffic, however, we will have the works area coned and inaccessible to both vehicles and pedestrians. Please park vehicles away from the works to prevent obstruction.

As with any construction work, some noise and disruption are expected. Please be assured that we will make every effort to minimise inconvenience. A Durham County Council supervisor will be present on site should you require assistance.
